Pupil Book Study

You can tell a lot from talking with pupils about their books and work. Are all the things we do, having the effect we planned? Pupil book/work study reveals the substance of the curriculum and supports curriculum impact evaluations.

Clare will show how pupil book/work study can be used as a quality assurance tool for school leaders, rather than a standards tool.

During the session we will look at aspects that strengthen or limit pupil understanding, including:-

- Knowledge
- Sequence
- Implementation
- Productivity
- Vocabulary
- Transcription
- Information Retention
- Improvement

These 8 aspects of a well-designed curriculum will be used to evaluate the quality of learning in books/work, plan questions to ask pupils as part of further quality assurance activities and indicate how to take actions as a result.
