



Instructional Coaching - the most effective route to improvement in the classroom

- Instructional Coaching is an observation and feedback cycle that pairs trained in-school coaches with classroom teachers
- Instructional coaching is an improvement partnership, not a one-way annual observation
- Guided by the Jim Knight instructional coaching group approach, and including opportunities to practice together, this live online course will prepare participants to use instructional coaching in their own setting and offer an ongoing support network
